Guest Speakers

PETER GILLEN — A native of Brooklyn NY, Coach Gillen chose to follow the college coaching career path after an outstanding run as a New York City High School coach. In 20 years as a collegiate head coach, Coach Gillen's teams compiled an overall record of 392-221 (.639 winning percentage) and participated in postseason play 16 times. Gillen was the Head Coach at Xavier for 9 years, at Providence for 4 years, and at Virginia for 7 years. His 1997 Providence team reached the championship game of the NCAA Tournament's Southeast Regional before losing to eventual national champion Arizona. Coach Gillen has served as an assistant coach for Dream Team II that won a gold medal at the World Championships in Toronto in the summer of 1994. Coach Gillen is currently serving as a college basketball analyst for the Westwood One and ESPN networks.

JOHN O'CONNOR — A native Philadelphian, John began his coaching career at Bishop McDevitt HS and Germantown Academy. Having been instrumental in the development of both of these High School programs, John made the jump to the college ranks at Villanova, Drexel, Lafayette, and currently at Georgia Tech.

"Johnny O" is one of the most sought after basketball clinicians in the nation; known for his enthusiastic approach to the fundamentals of the game.

STEVE CHADWIN — In his 28 years at the Abington Friends School, Steve Chadwin has built the program from the ground up. Coach Chadwin has guided the Kangaroos to 486 wins and 15 Friends School League Championships. Coach has guided many young men to collegiate basketball careers at places such as: Amherst College, Boston University, New Mexico State, Penn, Xavier, Penn State, Lehigh, Immaculata and many others.

GREG DOWNER — Gregg Downer recently complete his 17th year as Head Coach at Lower Merion High School in Ardmore, PA. During his tenure he has compiled a record of 320-155, while guiding the Aces to 2 State Championships, 8 Central League titles, 6 District 1 Final Four appearances and 8 State Playoff appearances. In addition to the team accolades, nearly 20 of Coach Downer's players have gone on to play College Basketball and one player — Kobe Bryant — is a current NBA star.
